

USE OF VALIDATION AND VERIFICATION STATEMENT

- OASISCERT has established rules governing use of its validation and verification statement that OASISCERT authorizes its certified clients to use(OSC-AP-04). These rules shall ensure, among other things, traceability back to OASISCERT through the use of reference number assigned to each statement.
- 2. It shall be used only in relation to the claim which has been validated/verified and shall not be misleading with regards to product certification.
- 3. OASISCERT has the right to request a responsible party to remove any inappropriate references or use of the validation and verification statement.
- 4. The responsible party is required to notify OASISCERT regarding the use of the validation or verification (VV) statement on their website, brochure, marketing materials, or any other promotional material.
- 5. The validation statements can only be used for validated projects and verification statements can only be used for verified projects.
- 6. The responsible party can use the "short-form" or "long-form" validated or verified environmental information statements as in Table 1.

Note 1 "Include" means that the long-form reference is provided in close proximity to the short-form reference in the same medium.

Note 2 "Make reference to" means that a reference to the location of the long-form reference in another medium (e.g., website) is provided near the short-form reference.

Subject matter is	Short form	Long form
Verification a)	Verified at the reasonable level of assurance	In its opinion dated 20xx-xx-xx, OASISCERT concluded with reasonable assurance that the data and information in our statement were fairly stated.
Verification b)	Verified at the limited level of assurance	In its opinion dated 20xx-xx-xx, OASISCERT, stated that it had not found " no evidence to indicate that the data and information in our statement were not fairly stated.
Validation	Validated	In its opinion dated 20xx-xx-xx, OASISCERT, stated that it had not found any evidence to indicate that the assumptions, methods and limitations that we cited in our statement did not provide a reasonable basis for our projections or forecasts.

- a) Historical data and information submitted for verification may be monitored, estimated or modeled.
- b) When a responsible party refers to a statement as "verified", the long-form reference applies to any reference implying verification, e.g. by using words such as "verified", "third-party verified" or "verified by [name of body]."
